What's the point?

- Achieve a nationally recognised NVQ Award.
- Improve the running of your operation.
- Personal achievement and self esteem.
- Career development
- A legal requirement for Waste Management Licence holders.

How long does it take?

- 6 to 12 months is the average, faster if you need.
- Monthly visits are usually planned and executed by your SERAC assessor.
- The better prepared you are the quicker you will progress.

Which award?

- There are 22 awards.
- Each designed to best suit your operation.
- Determined by the type of waste, and which kind of facility, you manage.
- To make sure that the correct award is selected, the Environment Agency must be consulted – TRACKSS can offer guidance with this.

What do I have to do?

- Fill in a Candidate Registration Form and send the enrolment fee.
- We appoint an assessor and get you started as soon as possible.
- Following registration we provide each candidate with a comprehensive information pack to help them understand their award.
- You will have to demonstrate competency in each Unit of the award.
- Your designated assessor will guide you every step of the way.
- Satisfy the assessor that you understand the necessary legal issues for your NVQ.

Where do I have to go??

- Nowhere - it takes place at your workplace to maximise assessment by observation.
- We'll ask questions to make sure candidates understand key information
- TRACKSS also provides off-site training courses, particularly on legal matters, when needed.
