

# WASTE PRODUCERS

## CIWM - Waste Awareness Certificate – Code WAC1

- **Duration:** 1 Day
- **Target audience:** Anyone whose work practices produce waste or those who need a greater understanding of waste principles..
- **Learning Objectives:**
  - Understanding different types, natures and quantities of waste.
  - An explanation of the current waste management practices and disposal routes within the framework of the wastes hierarchy.
  - How to promote best practice in waste management.
  - Introduction to waste related legislation, in particular the Duty of Care,
  - Understanding the health and safety issues in the handling, movement and storage of wastes.

## Introduction to Wastes – Code WPT2

- **Duration:** 1/2 Day
- **Target audience:** First line operatives producing or handling wastes.
- **Learning Objectives:**
  - To provide a basic knowledge of types of wastes and their impacts.
  - Environmental, health and safety issues of wastes.
  - How to segregate and minimise wastes.

This course can be adapted to focus on the problems of waste and opportunities for a specific industry sector. Industry specific courses are available for the **construction, healthcare and quarrying sectors.**

## Duty of Care Regulations – Code WPT3

- **Duration:** 1 Day
- **Target audience:** Personnel responsible for dispatching or receiving wastes.
- **Learning Objectives:**
  - Understanding responsibilities under the Duty of Care.
  - Legislation requirements for Waste Carriers' Certificates and EWC Catalogue.
  - Familiarisation with the revision to the Code of Practice.

## Hazardous Waste Regulations 2005 and ADR – Code WPT4

- **Duration:** 1 Day
- **Target audience:** Any personnel involved with the production, handling, storage or dispatch of, hazardous waste.
- **Learning Objectives:**
  - How to classify hazardous waste accurately.
  - How to notify waste or register premises.
  - How to complete consignment notes, records and returns to the Environment Agency.
  - Understand the requirements for transporting hazardous loads in the UK by road.
  - Understand the interface of the ADR regulations with other safety legislation.

### **Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment – Code WPT5**

- **Duration:** 1 Day
- **Target audience:** Personnel responsible for handling or managing the handling of electrical and electronic wastes.
- **Learning Objectives:**  
Understand the types of wastes affected by the latest legal regulations.  
Review the options for the correct disposal of these wastes – including compliance schemes.  
How to meet recycling targets and record keeping requirements.

### **Dealing with Healthcare Wastes – Code WPT6**

- **Duration:** 1 Day
- **Target audience:** Personnel responsible for handling or managing healthcare wastes.
- **Learning Objectives:**  
Study the latest guidance from the Department of Health.  
How to audit healthcare wastes streams.  
Best practice for segregation and handling of healthcare wastes.  
Impacts for transport of healthcare wastes.
